THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1936.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 60 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export Duty (Carobs) Order, 1937.
2. From and after the date hereof there shall be levied and collected upon the exportation of carobs an export duty at the rate of two piastres for each Aleppo Cantar.
3. The Order in Council No. 1618 dated the 28th day of December, 1934, and published under Notification No. 1367 in the *Gazette* of the 28th December, 1934, is hereby revoked.
