In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 34 of the Newspaper, Books and Printing Presses Laws, 1934 to 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Newspaper ("Kairon") Prohibition Order, 1937.

2. From and after the date hereof the introduction or circulation in the Colony of the Newspaper set out in the Schedule hereto is prohibited.
