THE DEFENCE (CERTAIN BRITISH POSSESSIONS)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1928.

PROCLAMATION MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER ARTICLE II.

Whereas by Proclamation dated the 22nd day of October, 1931, and published under Notification No. 868 in the Gazette of the 23rd day of October, 1931, the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Article II of the Defence (Certain British Possessions) Order in Council, 1928, (hereinafter called "the said Order in Council"), proclaimed the said Order in Council in the Colony and further proclaimed that the said Order in Council should come into operation in the Colony on and from the 22nd day of October, 1931:

And whereas the said Order in Council is still in operation in the Colony:

And whereas it is considered that the said Order in Council and the Regulations made thereunder should now cease to be in operation in the Colony:

Now, therefore, I, Herbert Richmond Palmer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Article II of the said Order in Council and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do by this Proclamation declare that the said Order in Council and the Defence of Cyprus (Consolidation and Amendment) Regulations, 1931 to 1936, (hereinafter called "the said Regulations"), shall cease to be in operation in the Colony as from the date hereof:

Provided that nothing in this Proclamation contained shall affect or shall be construed as affecting the previous operation of, or anything duly done or suffered under, the said Order in Council and the said Regulations.

Given at Nicosia, this 28th day of May, 1937.
