THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Kato Amiandos, in the District of Limassol, on the 19th day of July, 1936, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kato Amiandos :

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Kato Amiandos has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Limassol a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor :

And whereas the Governor has decided to limit the area in the said report described :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kato Amiandos in the District of Limassol.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

The boundary begins at the most western point of plot No. 75 of the Government of Cyprus Survey plan No. XXXVII/54, on the

right bank of the river "Amiandos," and goes south-westwards along this bank of this river to the most southern point of plot No. 45 of the Government of Cyprus Survey plan No. XLVII/6; thence north-westwards along the southern boundary of this plot to the eastern side of the main road from Limassol to "Karvounas"; thence northwards and north-westwards along this side of this main road to the point due east of the most eastern point of plot No. 182 of the Government of Cyprus Survey plan No. XXXVII/62; thence crossing the main road to this point of this plot and passing along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 182, 181, 103, 102, 73, 74, 75, 76, 88, 86, 84, 83, 82, 81, 41, 93, 95, 37, 9, 14, 15, 16, 17, of the said plan, and plot No. 75 of the Government of Cyprus Survey plan No. XXXVII/54, to the starting point.

The area reserved comprises 274 donums approximately, as shown edged in red on the Government of Cyprus Survey plan Serial No. 1,092.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1937.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1937, His Excellency the Governor, on the report of the Director of Education, is pleased to order and hereby orders that the Village Commissions for the Orthodox-Christian Schools in the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall in their respective villages provide, erect, repair, extend, improve or develop any school buildings, premises, play grounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings, as the case may be, particulars whereof are given in the second column of the said Schedule.

Karavostasi Extension of two schools and erection of five teachers' dwellings.
