THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export Amendment Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export Regulations, 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export Regulations, 1935 and 1937.

2. Regulation 10 (1) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By the addition of the following proviso to paragraph (c) thereof :—

" Provided that the Produce Inspector may dispense with this requirement when in his opinion the potatoes are of a size suitable for seed purposes in the market to which the consignment is intended to be exported."

(b) By the addition thereto of the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (c) :—

“(d) All potatoes in each consignment shall be of the variety marked on each box containing such potatoes as in Regulation 10 (2) (a) hereof provided and shall be true to the type of that variety.”
