THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Onions) Export Amendment Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce (Onions) Export Regulations, 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Onions) Export Regulations, 1936, and 1937.

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion in item 4 (relating to Picklers) of the figure "1½" and the substitution therefor of the figure "1¼".

3. Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso :—

"Provided that onions graded as "commercial" shall not be exported either directly or indirectly to any of the following countries, that is to say : Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Holland, The Irish Free State, Norway, Sweden and The United Kingdom."

THE IMMIGRATION LAW, 1936.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 (3) (b) of the Immigration Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that British Consular visas be dispensed with in the case of any alien who permanently resides in the Colony and who has obtained from the Principal Immigration Officer an endorsement on his passport under Regulation 4 of the Immigration Regulations, 1936, verifying the fact of his permanent residence in the Colony.
