FIRST SCHEDULE.

Xeros Quarter of Karavostasi Village.

The boundary begins at the most western point of plot No. 64 of the Government Survey plan XIX/58, where the main road from Lefka to Karavostasi meets the main road from Morphou to Polis, and proceeds due northwards to the seashore; thence north-eastwards, along the seashore, to the mouth of the river "Lefkatis," locality "Paleoalakaton," on the boundary of the village of Karavostasi; thence south-eastwards and south-westwards along this village boundary to the point in which the eastern boundary of the railway from Xeros to Mavrovouni Mine meets the main road from Lefka to Karavostasi; thence north-westwards along this side of this road to the starting point.

THE MINES REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) LAW, 1925.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 4.

Whereas it has been shown to the satisfaction of the Governor that quarry No. 22 situated at Yerolakkos in the Nicosia District is in such condition as to render mining and quarrying operations dangerous to the safety of workmen employed in or about the aforesaid quarry:
