### AREA "C":

The boundary begins at the most northern point of plot No. 251 of the Government Survey plan No. XXXIX/22, on a track and on the boundary of the village of Ayia Varvara, and goes north-eastwards along this track to the said village, to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 1306 of the Government Survey plan No. XXXIX/14; thence southwards and south-westwards along the road to the village of Mathiati to the most southern point of plot No. 136 of the said plan, locality "Selladhia," on the boundary of the village of Ayia Varvara; thence northwards along this village boundary to the starting point.

The areas reserved comprise 4,248 donums approximately, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 469/33.
