No. 164. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 1107, published in the Gazette of the 20th September, 1935, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Moslem Community of the town of Nicosia, in the District of Nicosia:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 1st day of January, 1938, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burialground above referred to has been provided.

THE ANTIQUITIES LAW, 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 33.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 33 of the Antiquities Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Antiquities (Dealers) Amendment Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Antiquities (Dealers) Regulations, 1936, (hereinafter called "The Principal Gazette; Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Antiquities (Dealers) Regulations, 1936 and 1937.
