## The Customs Law, 1936.

NOTIFICATION.

It is hereby notified that in exercise of the powers vested in him by the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the persons whose names are set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the person whose name is set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule.
