THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 AND 1934.

RULES MADE UNDER SECTION 114.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 114 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 and 1934, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Audit Fees) Rules, 1937.

2. The Municipal Corporations in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall pay into the general revenue of the Colony the fee in the second column therein prescribed respectively on account of the services of the Government Auditor with respect to audit of accounts for a period of twelve months :

Provided that a *pro rata* fee shall be paid by the Municipal Corporation concerned with respect to audit of accounts for any shorter period.

3. The fee by these Rules prescribed shall be paid by every Municipal Corporation within ten days from the publication of the respective copy of the accounts in the *Gazette*.

4. These Rules shall come into force on the 1st January, 1938, and thereupon the Municipal Corporations (Audit Fees) Rules, 1933, shall be revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
