#### The Irrigation Laws, 1931 and 1934.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 18 of the Irrigation Law, 1931, the following Rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Psomolophou, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*. (M.P. 658/34.)

#### IRRIGATION DIVISION OF PSOMOLOPHOU.

#### Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Psomolophou (Amendment) Rules, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Psomolophou Rules, 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Rules"), and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Psomolophou Rules, 1936 and 1937.

2. Rule 5 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "as may be prescribed by the Committee from time to time" between the words "annum" and "for",
