THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1936.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

H. R. PALMER,

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to erect a Government Sanatorium at the village of Kyperounda in the District of Limassol :

Now, therefore, I, Herbert Richmond Palmer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1936, do hereby declare the acquisition of land at the village of Kyperounda in the District of Limassol and the erection thereon of a Government Sanatorium to be an undertaking of public utility, and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Commissioner of Limassol the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.

No. 201. The Rural Constables Laws, 1932 to 1937.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 3.
