No. 210. 5 THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1761

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Coal and Firewood)

Exemption Order, 1937.

2. All coal and firewood imported into the Colony shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 71.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

Whereas His Excellency the Governor has, under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, ordered the Town Committees and Village Commissions for Orthodox-Christian Schools mentioned in the second column of the Schedule hereto to provide school buildings, premises, playgrounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings:

And whereas the necessary estimates and plans have been prepared

under section 53 of the above-mentioned Laws:

And whereas loans amounting to the sums mentioned in the third column of the Schedule hereto have, under section 51 (1) and (2), been raised to meet the expense of providing such buildings as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that in order to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loans aforesaid the sums of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule hereto be recovered respectively from the church or churches, monastery or throne and the Orthodox-Christian inhabitants of the towns and villages mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule in manner provided by section 72 of the above Laws.

THE PRISON DISCIPLINE LAW, 1879.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 4.

H. R. PALMER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Prison Discipline Law, 1879, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prison (Amendment) Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Prison Regulations, 1908 to 1936, (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Prison Regulations, 1908 to 1937.

2. Regulation 129 of the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"Prison food.

129. Prisoners before trial who do not provide themselves with food shall receive the quantity of food specified in dietary No. 3 prescribed in Schedule C. hereto."

3. Regulation 141 of the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—
"Bation" 141 Subject to the subjec

"Ration scales."

141. Subject to the provisions of Regulation 43, every convicted prisoner shall receive the quantity of food specified in the scale of dietary, prescribed in Schedule C. hereto."

4. Regulation 192 of the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—
"Diet scale. 192. The scale of dietary as laid down in Schedule C. hereto shall be strictly adhered to."
