In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Pharmacy Laws, 1900 and 1926, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to vary the Schedule to the said Laws and to declare that Thallium and its preparations shall be added to the said Schedule:

Provided that nothing in this Notice contained shall apply to preparations of Thallium which—  $\,$ 

- (a) are contained in a closed package or vessel distinctly labelled with a notice of the special purpose for which the preparation is intended; and
- (b) are sold or supplied upon a request in writing stating the name and address of the person by whom such preparation is to be used.
