THE TRADES AND INDUSTRIES (REGULATION) LAW, 1937.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1763.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 (1) of the Trades and Industries (Regulation) Law, 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trades and Industries (Regulated Trade Areas) Order, 1937.

2. The areas set out in the Schedule hereto shall be and are hereby declared to be Regulated Trade Areas for the purposes of the Law.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1938.

6. The area comprised within the municipal limits of Famagusta.
7. The area comprised within the municipal limits of Paphos.
8. The area comprised within the municipal limits of Kyrenia.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 (1) of the Trades and Industries (Regulation) Law, 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trades and Industries (Regulated Trades) Order, 1937.

2. The trades and industries set out in the Schedule hereto shall be and are hereby declared to be regulated trades for the purposes of the Law when carried on in all or any of the areas which have been declared to be Regulated Trade Areas by the Trades and Industries (Regulated Trade Areas) Order, 1937.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1938.
