THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1936.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1730

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

H. R. PALMER,
Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Articles for Exhibition) Exemption Order, 1937.

2. From and after the date hereof, works of art, artistic collections, specimens or objects of archaeological or historical interest imported into the Colony and—

- (a) consigned to a public institution approved as such by the Governor, and
 - (b) proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller to be imported solely for exhibition purposes in, by, or on behalf of such institution, and
 - (c) re-exported within such time as the Comptroller may determine,
- shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.
