PROHIBITION ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 41.

Holding of Fairs.

Whereas the dangerous infectious disease known as Epidemic Cerebro-Spinal Meningitis exists in all the Districts of the Colony;

Now, therefore, I, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 41 of the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 and 1937, hereby prohibit as from the date of the publication of this order and until further order the holding of fairs and any other festivals in all the Districts of the Colony.
