THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1936.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1735

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

H. R. PALMER, -
Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Articles for the Celebration of the Coronation) Exemption Order, 1937.

2. From and after the date hereof, the following articles, that is to say—

- (a) fireworks, and
- (b) red, white and blue bunting, and
- (c) red and blue electric light globes,

imported into the Colony and—

(i) proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller to be of British Empire origin, and

(ii) certified by a Commissioner to be imported for use for or in connection with the celebration of the Coronation of His Majesty,

shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Lophos, in the District of Limassol, on the 13th day of October, 1935, it was determined by the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Lophos:

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described:

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Lophos has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Limassol a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 and 1935, prescribed:

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor:

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient that the area described in the said report should be limited :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Lophos in the District of Limassol.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say:—

The boundary begins at the north-western corner of plot No. 563, plan No. XLVII/51, locality "Plakati," on a track, and goes eastwards and south-eastwards, passing along the boundaries of, and including in the reserved area, plot No. 563 of the same plan, plots Nos. 227, 226, 225, 304, 305, 306, 346, 347, 348, 350, 351, 353, 354, 362, 363, 369, 370, 457, plan No. XLVII/52, locality "Piyi," to the most northern point of plot No. 457, on the road from the village of Lophos to Limassol; thence south-eastwards, along the western side of this road, to the most northern point of plot No. 335, plan No. XLVII/60; thence westwards and southwards, passing along the boundaries of, and including in the reserved area, plots Nos. 397, 391, 392, 394, 395, 387, 388, 356, 297, 300, 299, 298, 295, 303, 305, 302, 306, 494.3, 226, 93, 94, 211, 212, 208, 100, 101, 107, 106, 157, 108, 109, 206, 196, 195, 194, 193, 192, 189, 161, 186, 182, 181, 168, 180, 69, 170, 172, plan No. XLVII/60, to the most southern point of plot No. 172, on a track and on the boundary of the village of Lophos; thence north-westwards, along this village boundary, which is the track, to the most eastern point of plot No. 158 of the same plan, locality "Kaparetti"; thence north-westwards along the aforesaid track to the starting point.

The area reserved comprises 1,657 donums approximately, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 702/35.
