THE BURIALS LAW, 1896.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 1.

Whereas the village of Karavostasi in the District of Nicosia is not provided with a place for the burial of the dead for the use of the Orthodox-Christian Community of the village:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Burials Law, 1896, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that a burial-ground, shall be provided for the said village for the purpose aforesaid under the provisions of the said Law.
