2. The importation into the Colony of any motor lory excecding in size or capacity the standard 30 cwt. capacity type, or having a wheelhase exceeding 136 inches in length, or having twin rear wheels, is prohibited save under a licence under the hand of the Colonial secretary and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.
3. The Order in Council No. 1506 of the 8th daty of November, 1932 , published in the Gazette of the 11th day of Novemher, 1932, is hereby revoked.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Gamantine Law, 1932, His Excellency the Gdvernor, with the advice of the Exerutive Council, is pleased to make and herqby makes the following herrulations:-

1. These Regulations may be fited as the Quarantine (Public: Health) Amendment Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Guammine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Recrulatious may together be cited as the Quarantine (PublicHealth) Requlations, 1935 and 19:3.
2. Regulation 15 of the Prindipal Regulations is herehy repeated and the following Regulation substituted therefor:-
" 15 . In case of an outlpreak of plague, cholera, typhus, smallpox, epidemic cerebro-spinal meningitis or diphtheria the Director of Medical Services or any Government/Medical Officer authorized by him may order the evacuation of any house which in his opinion is within the range of infection or may order the isolation and keeping isolated of any town or village or part of any town or village, or any lane or street in any $\mathrm{y}^{\text {nart of }}$ any town or village."
