ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 71.

Whereas His Excellency the Acting Governor has, under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1936, by Order published under Notification No. 843 in the *Gazette* dated the 4th day of September, 1936, ordered the Committee of Management for Maronite Schools to provide buildings for Girls' School and Mistresses' residence in the village of Kormakiti, in the District of Kyrenia:

And whereas loans amounting to the sums mentioned in the third column of the Schedule hereto have, under section 51 (1) and (2), been raised to meet the expense of providing such buildings as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1936, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that in order to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loans aforesaid the sums of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule hereto be recovered from the Maronite inhabitants of the village mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule in manner provided by section 74 (1) of the above Laws.
