

or crew the necessary assistance; any such person may, however, be considered as a contact and subjected to disinfection, surveillance or observation as the Medical Officer may consider proper.

37. Persons under observation or surveillance shall give facilities for all clinical or bacteriological investigations which are considered necessary by the Medical Officer.

THE AIR NAVIGATION (COLONIES, PROTECTORATES AND  
MANDATED TERRITORIES) ORDER, 1927.

(ARTICLE 27 (2).)

SPECIAL AND TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION.

In exercise of the power vested in him by the Air Navigation (Colonies, Protectorates and Mandated Territories) Order, 1927, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to grant and hereby grants special and temporary authorization to Misr Airwork S.A.E., (hereinafter called "the Company"), whose registered offices are at Almaza Aerodrome, Heliopolis, Cairo, Egypt—

(a) to establish an air service (which term includes a regular air service and/or occasional special charter and taxi flights) to and from Cyprus, and

(b) for the purposes of such service, for aircraft of the Company to fly within the limits of, and to land in, Cyprus.

2. This Authorization is subject to the following conditions, that is to say:—

(1) That aircraft of the Company may land either—

(a) at the Nicosia Landing Ground, or

(b) at any other place previously approved by the Governor.

(2) That in the event of the Company establishing a regular air service to Nicosia, with a definite schedule of the time of arrivals at Nicosia, 24 hours' notice of the first proposed landing thereat shall be given by the Company to the Colonial Secretary.

(3) That in the event of the Company desiring to effect a landing at any other place except Nicosia, 48 hours' notice of such proposed landing shall be given by the Company to the Colonial Secretary and to the Director of Public Works, and in every such case the Company shall pay all costs incurred by the Government of Cyprus in respect of and in connection with such landing.

(4) That every landing of aircraft of the Company shall be subject to Quarantine and Customs requirements and restrictions in force for the time being.

3. This Authorization is valid for a period of six months from the date hereof.
