No. 1. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2220
MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption (Amendment) Order, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption Order, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this order may together be cited as the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption Orders, 1946.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of item (b) and the substitution therefor of the following item:—

"(b) expanded metal and steel to be used for the support of underground workings."

3. This order shall be deemed to have been made and to have taken effect on the 12th day of October, 1946.

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 3.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by Defence Regulation 3 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, do hereby appoint the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing to be a Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulations 61, 61A, 63 and 83 as set out in the aforesaid Schedule.
