SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 101. THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 189, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st June, 1944, is hereby cancelled.

Local area	Dangerous infectious disease
Bombay (India)	Cholera.
Palestine	Typhus, Smallpox and Plague.
Turkey	Typhus, Smallpox and Plague.
Anglo-Egyptian Sudan	Smallpox.
Egypt	Typhus, Smallpox and Plague.
Iraq	Typhus and Smallpox.
Syria	Typhus and Smallpox.
