THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2237

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with Gazettes: the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946, (hereinafter Supplement referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be sited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) 31, 1,1946 Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to 1947.
