THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1943.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2238

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Athna to contract a loan.

WINSTER,

Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1943, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Athna (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Bank of Cyprus Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the lender"), the sum of three hundred and fifty pounds (£350) at a rate of interest not exceeding four and a half per centum ($4\frac{1}{2}\%$) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) The sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lender in seven equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).
- (b) The Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the amount borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate.
- (c) The sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the purpose of purchasing a shop and the adjoining yard which is now under the lease of the Village Health Commission and used as a meat market.
