# PRESCRIPTION OF GROUPS.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6 (2).

WINSTER,

- I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 (2) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order and prescribe as follows:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Elementary Education (Prescription of Schools) Orders, 1944 to 1946 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Schools) Orders, 1944 to 1947.
- 2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after items 1 and 2 of the following items, respectively:—

- 3. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order and the Second Schedule thereto are hereby deleted.
- 4. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "Kaimakli, Kuchuk (Omorphita)-Kaimakli, Beuyuk" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" in respect of the Moslem religious community.

#### THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

# No. 115. THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW, 1880.

# ORDER UNDER SECTION 2 (1) (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 (1) (1) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, 1880, duly deputed to me under section 4 of the said Law by paragraph 3 of the Notification No. 527 published in the Gazette of the 3rd July, 1931, I, Robert Jestin Roe, Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. All sheep and goats in the Colony, with the exception of sheep and goats within the village areas of the villages set out in the Schedule

hereto, shall be inoculated with anthrax vaccine.

2. The inoculations shall be carried out by Veterinary Officers or by such Vaccinators as may be appointed by me in writing in that behalf.

3. Every owner or person in charge of sheep or goats shall produce such sheep or goats for inoculation at such place and at such time as shall be appointed by a Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator as aforesaid by notice posted in a conspicuous place in the village concerned, and every such owner or person in charge shall render full assistance to the Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator in the inoculation of the sheep or goats as aforesaid.
