### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2240 MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Gazettes: Orders, 1946 to (No. 2) 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), Supplem Orders, 1946 to (No. 2) 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), Supplement and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post No. 3: (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 3) 1947.

## THE ARMY ACT.

# DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 189 (2).

WINSTER,

Governor,
I, the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 189 (2) of the Army Act, do hereby declare that, from the date of the signing of the peace treaty with Italy, all British troops serving in Cyprus will remain on active service within the meaning of the said section of the said Act.

This declaration shall remain in force for three months from the date

thereof.
