

No. 122.**THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 7 (1).

WINSTER,
Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 (2) and 7 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Austria) Order, 1947.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 3 of the Law, any person, unless I otherwise direct, may, except as provided in clause 3 hereof, trade within Austria with the Austrian state or with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein.

3. This Licence shall not extend to or authorize—

(a) the performance of any contract of insurance or reinsurance entered into with or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in clause 2 of this Order before the 13th August, 1946;

(b) the entering into of any agreement or contract of reinsurance with any body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) whose Registered Office is shown by the Register of the Austrian Commercial Court to be in Austria but whose Head Office is outside Austria in territory which, by virtue of section 12B of the Law, is to be treated for all the purposes of the Law as enemy territory;

(c) the payment of any bill of exchange payable in the Colony and drawn before the 13th August, 1946, to or for the benefit of any such person as aforesaid;

(d) the encashment of any coupons by or on behalf of any such person as aforesaid.

4. For the purpose of this Order "trade" is confined to supplying any goods to or for the benefit of the Austrian state or any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein, or to obtaining goods from the Austrian state, such individuals or bodies of persons and is deemed to include—

(a) transactions incidental to supplying or obtaining such goods; and

(b) the paying, transmitting or receiving of any money, negotiable instrument or security for money in respect of such trade.

5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 13th August, 1946.
