

11. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the following Schedule :—

“ SECOND SCHEDULE.

(Bye-law 199.)

ENTERTAINMENT DUTY.	<i>Rates.</i>
(i) On each ticket the total price of which does not exceed 4½p.	p. 1
(ii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 4½p. but does not exceed one shilling	2
(iii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds one shilling but does not exceed three shillings	3
(iv) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds three shillings but does not exceed four shillings	4½
(v) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds four shillings but does not exceed five shillings	6
(vi) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds five shillings but does not exceed ten shillings : on each shilling or part thereof of such price	1½
(vii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds ten shillings : on each shilling or part thereof of such price	2.”

**THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF FUEL AND CHARCOAL)
ORDER, 1944.**

NOTICE UNDER CLAUSE 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under clause 6 of the Defence (Control of Fuel and Charcoal) Order, 1944, I hereby revoke, with effect from to-day, Notification No. 17 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 20th January, 1944, whereby the following were declared Fuelwood Controlled areas :—

The town of Nicosia and the villages of Kaimakli, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Palouriotissa, Eylenja (Aglanja), Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Orta Keuy (Minzeli) and Strovolos in the Nicosia District.
