

No. 144.**THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.****LICENCE UNDER SECTION 3 (2).**

WINSTER,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 (2) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby authorize the payment of any fees or other moneys due for the granting or renewal of any Italian Patent, Design or Trade Mark and of any expenses in connection therewith, and for that purpose I further authorize the transmission to any person in Italy of any money, negotiable instrument or security for money.

2. This Licence shall be deemed to have been issued on the 12th March, 1947.

No. 145.**THE MISSIONARY EDUCATIONAL AND MEDICAL (ALIEN REGULATION) LAWS, 1922 AND 1933.****PERMIT UNDER SECTION 8.**

WINSTER,

Governor.

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Laws, 1922 and 1933, the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto have applied for permits under the provisions of the said Laws;

And whereas the said persons have severally given an undertaking in writing to pay all due obedience and respect to the Government of Cyprus, and while carefully abstaining from participation in political affairs, that they desire and purpose *ex animo* to work in friendly co-operation with the said Government in all matters in which their influence might properly be exerted; and, in particular, they have undertaken that if engaged in educational work, their influence will be exerted to promote loyalty to the Government of Cyprus in the minds of their pupils, and to make them good citizens of the British Empire;

Now, therefore, I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Laws, 1922 and 1933, do hereby grant to the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto a permit respectively to commence or carry on the work set down after their respective names.
