No. 16. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2221 MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Orders, 1940 to Gazettes: 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Supplement Order and this order may together be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Orders, 1940 to 1947.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to "Small Packets" under the heading "FOR ABROAD", sub-heading "TO ANY DESTINATION ABROAD" and the substitution therefor of the following entries:

" Small Packets: Piastres.

Not exceeding 10 oz. For every additional 2 oz. or fraction thereof 14" 3. This Order shall come into force on the 20th day of January, 1947.
