No. 170. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2246
MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,
Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to 1947, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 2) 1947.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the insertion under the heading "SERVICE BY AIR THROUGHOUT", in its respective alphabetical order, of the following entry:—
