No. 1. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2220
MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption (Amendment) Order, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption Order, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this order may together be cited as the Import Duty (Certain Mining Material) Exemption Orders, 1946.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of item (b) and the substitution therefor of the following item:—

"(b) expanded metal and steel to be used for the support of underground workings."

3. This order shall be deemed to have been made and to have taken effect on the 12th day of October, 1946.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 3.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by Defence Regulation 3 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, do hereby appoint the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing to be a Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulations 61, 61A, 63 and 83 as set out in the aforesaid Schedule.

2. This appointment is in addition to and not in derogation of any other appointment made for the purposes of the said Defence Regulations or any of them in respect of any officer or person other than :—

(a) the Controller of Supplies ;

(b) the Controller of Transport & Marketing ; and

(c) the person appointed under Notification No. 176 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 23rd May, 1946,

but without prejudice to anything done by any such officer or person.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

DELEGATION OF POWER UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 55 (2).

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by paragraph (2) of Defence Regulation 55 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, do by this Order delegate to the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing all the powers conferred on the Governor by the provisions of paragraph (1) of the said Defence Regulation, without any limitations or conditions.

2. The delegation under Notification No. 224 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 18th June, 1942, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

No. 4. THE IMMIGRATION LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 31.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 31 of the Immigration Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Immigration Regulations, 1936 and 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Immigration Regulations, 1936 to 1946.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after regulation 11 of the following regulation :—

" 11A. The list to be furnished under section 14 of the Laws by the master of a ship and the pilot of every passenger carrying aircraft arriving from any place outside the Colony or departing from the Colony shall be in the Form B of the Second Schedule hereto and shall contain the information therein set out."
