A PROCLAMATION.

WINSTER,

Governor. Whereas His Majesty the King by Letters Patent bearing date the Twenty-fifth day of June, 1947, passed under the Great Seal of the Realm (hereinafter referred to as "the Letters Patent of 1947") has been graciously pleased to amend the Letters Patent bearing date the Tenth day of March, 1925, constituting the Office of Governor and Commanderin-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus and providing for the Government thereof, as amended by Letters Patent bearing date respectively the Twelfth day of November, 1931, and the First day of February, 1943:

And whereas by the Letters Patent of 1947 it is directed and enjoined that the Letters Patent of 1947 shall be published in the *Cyprus Gazette* and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the *Governor* by Proclamation in the said *Gazette*:

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Letters Patent of 1947, do hereby order and proclaim that the Letters Patent of 1947 shall come into operation on the 17th day of July, 1947.

Given at Troodos, this 9th day of July, 1947. GOD SAVE THE KING.

No. 202. THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY (TENURE, REGISTRATION AND VALUATION) LAW, 1945.

APPOINTMENT OF AUTHORITIES UNDER SECTION 16.

WINSTER, Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Immovable Property (Tenure, Registration and Valuation) Law, 1945, do hereby appoint the following bodies and persons as authorities for the purposes of the said section (relating to plantations adjacent to a public road) :---

- (a) in respect of any public roads within the several areas of the several municipal corporations, the Council of the Municipal Corporation exercising authority in the area concerned;
- (b) in respect of any public roads other than those mentioned in paragraph (a) above, the six Commissioners, each Commissioner in so far as his District is concerned.
