I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Government Lands Law, 1941, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order that the Schedule to the Notification No. 399 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 12th December, 1946, (relating to the grant of certain plots of land in Ayios Ioannis Quarter in the town of Nicosia) be amended by the deletion from the first column (under title "Name of Grantee") of the name "Maroulla D. Pickouniadou" (item 9) and the substitution therefor of the name "Panayota Chr. Nathanael" who is hereby constituted as the Grantee of the land appearing against item 9, in lieu of the Grantee now therein appearing, subject to the same conditions as in the said Notification contained, except that the said new Grantee shall not be required to pay the amount appearing in the last column of the said Schedule.
