**No. 208. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2252

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Medicines) Exemption Order, 1947.

2. The following medicine shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties, that is to say:—

The new anti-malarial medicine known as "Paludrin".
