#### NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

#### WINSTER,

### Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 19th day of December, 1946, and published under No. 417 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 27th December, 1946, relating to the establishment of a permanent Military Camp at or near the locality Kolokosh in the District of Nicosia, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to sanction and hereby sanctions the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated within the limits of the village of Ayios Dhometios, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, published under Notification No. 69 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 27th February, 1947, to vest and be registered in the name of His Majesty's Military Authorities.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 2 (5) AND 9.

WINSTER,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2 (5) and 9 of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) (Hungary and Roumania) Order, 1947.

Orders, 1940 and 1941, (requiring payment of certain moneys to the Custodian and imposing restrictions and requirements in regard to certain property in the Colony) shall not apply to-

- (a) any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in clause 3 of this Order by reason of any trade authorized by clause 2 of the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Hungary and Roumania) Order, 1947;
- (b) any property which comes into the ownership of any such person as aforesaid by reason of any such trade as aforesaid;
- (c) any money or property to which the above-mentioned clauses would apply only because any such persons as aforesaid became resident or commenced or recommenced to carry on business in any of the states specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall apply to the states specified in the Schedule hereto, any individual resident therein, and as respects any business carried on therein to any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business.

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation with regard to-

(a) Hungary, on the 27th August, 1946;

(b) Roumania, on the 14th April, 1947.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945. Rouched ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 7 (1). 48//18 3, 4 WINSTER.

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 (2) and 7 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Hungary and Roumania) Order, 1947.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 3 of the Law, any person, unless I otherwise direct, may, except as provided in clause 3 hereof, trade within the states specified in the Schedule hereto with such states or with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein.

3. This Licence shall not extend to or authorize-

(1) the performance of any contract of insurance or reinsurance entered into with or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in clause 2 of this Order before the date of the coming into operation of this Order:
