

2. Clauses 3, 6 and 7 of the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Orders, 1940 and 1941, (requiring payment of certain moneys to the Custodian and imposing restrictions and requirements in regard to certain property in the Colony) shall not apply to—

- (a) any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in clause 3 of this Order by reason of any trade authorized by clause 2 of the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Hungary and Roumania) Order, 1947 ;
- (b) any property which comes into the ownership of any such person as aforesaid by reason of any such trade as aforesaid ;
- (c) any money or property to which the above-mentioned clauses would apply only because any such persons as aforesaid became resident or commenced or recommenced to carry on business in any of the states specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall apply to the states specified in the Schedule hereto, any individual resident therein, and as respects any business carried on therein to any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business.

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation with regard to—

- (a) Hungary, on the 27th August, 1946 ;
- (b) Roumania, on the 14th April, 1947.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945. *Revised by*

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 7 (1). *48/118 s. 4.*

WINSTER,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 (2) and 7 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Hungary and Roumania) Order, 1947.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 3 of the Law, any person, unless I otherwise direct, may, except as provided in clause 3 hereof, trade within the states specified in the Schedule hereto with such states or with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein.

3. This Licence shall not extend to or authorize—

- (1) the performance of any contract of insurance or reinsurance entered into with or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in clause 2 of this Order before the date of the coming into operation of this Order;

(2) the payment of any bill of exchange payable in the Colony and drawn before the date of the coming into operation of this Order to or for the benefit of any such person as aforesaid;

(3) the encashment of any coupons or bonds by or on behalf of any such person as aforesaid.

4. For the purpose of this Order "trade" is confined to supplying any goods to or for the benefit of the states specified in the Schedule hereto or any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein, or to obtaining goods from such states, individuals or bodies of persons and is deemed to include—

(a) transactions incidental to supplying or obtaining such goods; and

(b) the paying, transmitting or receiving of any money, negotiable instrument or security for money in respect of such trade.

5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation with regard to—

(a) Hungary, on the 27th August, 1946;

(b) Roumania, on the 14th April, 1947.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE TREASURER UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Treasurer, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), (which renders ineffective, except with my sanction, the transfer by or on behalf of enemies of negotiable instruments and choses in action), do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (*Transfer of Negotiable Instruments, etc.*) (*Hungary and Roumania*) Order, 1947.

2. I do hereby sanction—

(a) any assignment of a chose in action which comes into the ownership of the Government or a person to whom this Order applies;

(b) any transfer of a negotiable instrument issued on or after the coming into operation of this Order;

(c) any transfer of any security transferable by delivery, not being a bond, a coupon or a negotiable instrument, which comes into the ownership of the Government or a person to whom this Order applies,

being an assignment or transfer made by reason of any trade authorized by clause 2 of the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (*Hungary and Roumania*) Order, 1947, by or on behalf of the Government or person to whom this Order applies.
