## THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 114, published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of

the 22nd April, 1947, is hereby cancelled.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF PAPHOS.
