

No. 227. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, and duly deputed to me, I hereby approve the area described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the person whose name is set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the firms whose names are set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing in drums of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry of such goods therein, during a period ending on the 31st December, 1948.
