THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE TREASURER UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), (which renders ineffective, except with my sanction, the transfer by or on behalf of enemies of negotiable instruments and choses in action), I, the Treasurer, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Transfer of Negotiable Instruments, etc.) (Germany) Order, 1947.
 - 2. I do hereby sanction-
 - (a) any assignment of a chose in action which, on or after the 4th March, 1947, comes into the ownership of an authority or a person to whom this Order applies;

(b) any transfer of a negotiable instrument issued on or after the 4th March, 1947; and

(c) any transfer of any security transferable by delivery, not being a bond, a coupon or a negotiable instrument, which on or after the 4th March, 1947, comes into the ownership of an authority or a person to whom this Order applies,

being an assignment or transfer made on or after the 4th March, 1947, by reason of any trade authorized by clause 2 of the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Germany) Order, 1947, by or on behalf of an authority or person to whom this Order applies.

3. This Order applies—

(a) to any government, public or other authority in Germany,

(b) to any individual resident in Germany,

(c) as respects any business carried on in Germany, to any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business.
