For the purposes of this Order the expression "Germany" means Berlin and the French, British, American and Russian Military Zones of Germany as established by the statement by the Governments of the United Kingdom, the United States of America, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Provisional Government of the French Republic on the zones of occupation in Germany on the 5th June, 1945, and also those parts of the former German Reich which are at present administered by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 4th March, 1947.

(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Potatoes) Order, 1947.

2. In this Order—

“Authorized purchaser” means any person or body of persons whom I may appoint as such.

“Potatoes” means any potatoes produced in the areas of the villages referred to in the schedule hereto.
