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THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2258 MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Packing Paper for

Export of Powdered Umber) Exemption Order, 1947.

2. All paper proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs to be imported into the Colony solely for the purpose of being used for the lining of any kind of receptacle utilized in the export of powdered umber, shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

3. The import Duty (Packing Paper for Export of Powdered Umber)

Exemption Order, 1939, is hereby revoked.
