**THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS (RETAILERS
CLOSING HOURS) ORDER, 1945.**

**DIRECTION BY THE COMMISSIONER OF NICOSIA AND KYRENIA
UNDER CLAUSE 6 (a).**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by clause 6 (a) of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order, 1945, I hereby direct that, notwithstanding anything in the said Order contained, all licensed premises situate within the districts of Nicosia and Kyrenia shall be closed and remain closed from sunrise to 8 p.m. on the 5th day of October, 1947.

2. This direction shall not apply to any licensed premises the licensee of which is a person not belonging to the Greek-Orthodox Church.
