

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment No. 3) Bye-laws, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to (No. 3) 1947. *Gazettes: 26.6.1931 to Supplement No. 3: 17.7.1947.*

2. Bye-law 26 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (b) thereof and the substitution thereof of the following paragraph:—

"(b) For any other animal, 2*p.* per oke or part thereof of the carcass for the first 60 okes, 1*p.* for every oke or part thereof of such carcass in excess of the first 60 okes but not exceeding 140 okes, and 20 paras for every oke or part thereof of such carcass in excess of the first 140 okes."

3. These bye-laws shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th day of September, 1947.

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Acting Governor. (M.P. 806/11/3.)
