NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 28th day of June, 1947, and published under No. 186 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 3rd July, 1947, relating to the erection within the district of Larnaca of a power station, offices and workmen's quarters in connection with a scheme for the generation and supply of electricity in Cyprus, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to sanction and hereby sanctions the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated partly in the town of Larnaca and partly in the village of Livadhia in the district of Larnaca, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner of Larnaca published under Notification No. 250 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 21st August, 1947, to vest and be registered in the name of the Government.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

WINSTER,

Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that certain lands on which the Military Authorities constructed military roads, situated in the localities set out in the Schedule hereto, are needed, and should be acquired, for use as permanent public roads.

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare the acquisition of the said lands to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the said Laws, entrust the supervision of the said undertaking to the Commissioner of Famagusta.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF LOCALITIES.

Famagusta District.

The military roads known as "the Lefkoniko Bye-passes" situated in the following localities, in the village of Lefkoniko:

Afendrika, Kamares, Shezias, Postanika, Vounos, Zaftos, Malies, Kouzoularies.
