NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

WINSTER,

Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that certain lands on which the Military Authorities constructed a military road, situated in the locality set out in the Schedule hereto, are needed and should be acquired, for use as permanent public road.

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare the acquisition of the said lands to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the said Laws, entrust the supervision of the said undertaking to the Commissioner of Larnaca.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF LOCALITY.

Larnaca District.

The military road known as "the Athienou Bye-pass" situated in the locality "Near the village", in the village of Athienou.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

Order made by a Competent Authority under Defence Regulation 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Amendment of Certain Orders) Order, 1947, and shall be read in conjunction with the Orders referred to in the first column of the Schedule hereto.

- 2. The Orders referred to in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby amended as specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
- 3. Any order, permit, direction or certificate issued, given or granted under the Orders referred to in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to have been issued, given or granted under such Orders, respectively, as amended by this Order.
