# THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW, 1934.

#### NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law, 1934, I do hereby give notice that :---

- except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby, the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited;
- (2) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited.
